

## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

This Code of Conduct aims to align to the Football Australia and Football Queensland approach in promoting and strengthening the reputation of football in Australia by establishing a standard of performance, behaviour and professionalism for its participants and stakeholders.

Always play by the laws of the game

Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit

Do not argue with the match official. If you disagree, have your captain or coach approach the match official during a break in play or after the match is concluded

Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players are not acceptable or permitted behaviours

Work equally hard for yourself and / or your team. Your team's performance will benefit, so will you

Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player

Display modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat

Cooperate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition

Respect the rights and dignity of all participants regardless of their ability, cultural background or religion

Remove all jewellery prior to training and match play, as it is a hazard to you and those around you

Failure to adhere to this code of conduct may result in club-imposed penalties as deemed appropriate by the elected committee
